Policy Concerning Outside Organizations
Adopted by the Board of Trustees, February 17, 1993

The Board of Trustees recognizes that other groups or organizations, both public and private, may, from time to time, have goals that are, or are presented to be complementary to those of the Library. However, it is the policy of the Library to minimize entanglement with other groups or organizations. The Board of Trustees hereby states its position that the decisions and actions of other groups or organizations shall not be considered the decisions or actions of the Board of Trustees or the Library unless the Board adopts a resolution expressly and explicitly ratifying such decisions or actions.

This policy may be waived by the Board or the Library Director, and involvement with outside groups or organizations allowed, when, in their discretion, it is in the best interests of the Library to do so.
